TASTING NOTES

The 2016 Confession Red Wine is dark, rich and powerful in the glass. You are greeted by mulberry, cranberry sauce and wild berry on the nose, and are reminded of picking berries in a bramble patch. The wine has a freshness both on the nose and on the palate, with elegant, bright acidity. Notes of graham cracker pie crust, italian plums, a hint of red fruit, and Rutherford Dust mingle beautifully as they dance across your palate. This wine has a long, lingering finish with hints of French Oak and elegant tannins.

Pair with herb crusted rack of lamb
or boeuf bourgignon.

10% Merlot, 8% Petite Sirah
